Release PosLink 1.0.3.177



Summary

This document contains details of the features for PosLink that have been developed and released as part of release 1.0.3.177. The release was deployed on the 07/01/2019.

The key features delivered in this release are:

- 🔗 Generic Kiosk Interface
- 🔗 Ability to restrict paid out transactions by payment type
- 🔗 Ability to adjust font sizes by terminal
- 🔗 Bug fixes

Feature Details

Interfaces

Added 'Generic Kiosk' endpoint and configuration screen [POSLINK-1011, POSLINK-1010, POSLINK-1028, POSLINK-1049]

New endpoints have been created that allow external kiosk systems to pass in order data to an EPOS terminal. The endpoints also allow a 3rd party to utilise functionality of the EPOS. This includes:

- Calculated tax values
- Automatic discount values
- Receipt information
- Staff Code validation for discount authorisation
- Available status

Terminal Configuration

Ability to change font size by Terminal [POSLINK-989]

A new tab has been added within the terminal configuration screen of the EPOS terminal, 'Font Sizes'.

This allows you to override the font size settings within Global Flags, which is useful for smaller devices such as tablets.

Functions

Limit the payments used for Paid Outs [POSLINK-953]

Function 132 – 'Paid Out' now contains a 'Media Restriction' option.

When set the function will only allow you to process a paid out transaction against the specified media type.

Fixes

Reorder function displaying print groups [POSLINK-899]

When using the re-order function on the EPoS terminal. If the items being re-ordered had condiments, the print groups for the condiments were displaying within the journal window of the PoS.

5Loyalty customer name displayed on rear display of PoS terminal [POSLINK-999]

If within Program Mode > Global Flags > Flags 1 > View Options 1 > No Customer Info on Rear Display is selected then the customer name will no longer show on the rear display.

Error sending sales data – maximum request length exceeded [POSLINK-1010]

When resending sales data from a PoS terminal in certain situations an error appeared due to the size of data being sent. A new method and process has been included to resolve this issue.

Set price adjustment with multiplier incorrect [POSLINK-1009]

There was an issue with adjustments calculating incorrectly when configured in a particular way. Within Adjustments, when the option -Flag1 - Reward value = basket subtotal if > basket subtotal is enabled then the basket subtotal is not calculated correctly for items with a quantity > 1.

Items can be added to a transaction after using the 'paid out' function [POSLINK-1039]

Code has been added to prevent the paid out function being included within the same transaction as selling items.
